Trouble, Trouble Boil And Bubble! Or Nebby Has A Nightmare!

Ever have a dream that is so real it wakes you up? I have, and in our story today Nebuchadnezzar has one. But what makes this story so interesting is that Nebby wants to know what his dream means!

P1 Dan 2:1 And in the second ^(so "about" how old is Daniel?) year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him. ^{His dream wakes him up!}

P2 Dan 2:2 Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to show the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king. ^{Nebby has some strange helpers. All of the underlined names in this verse has to do with people who in contact with evil spirits.}

P3 Dan 2:3 And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream. 4 Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriack ^{Syrian language}, O king, live for ever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation ^{what it means}.

P4 Dan 2:5 The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, The thing is gone from me ^{I forgot it}: if ye will not make known unto me the dream, with the interpretation thereof, ye shall be cut in pieces ^{ouchie}, and your houses shall be made a dunghill ^{a place where manure is dumped}. ^{Nebby is pretty smart. He knows if he tells them the dream they will make something up about the dream but if they can tell him his dream and what the dream means then he might believe them. (Wisdom)}

P5 Dan 2:6 But if ye show the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honour: therefore show me the dream, and the interpretation thereof. 7 They answered again ^{argued} and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation of it.

P6 Dan 2:8 The king answered and said, I know of certainty that ye would gain the time, ^{wasting time} because ye see the thing is gone from me. 9 But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, there is but one decree ^{to be cut in pieces} for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt ^{deceptive} words to speak before me, till the time be changed ^{or till I forget or something happens so I forget is what he means here.}: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can show me the interpretation thereof. ^{How is Nebby using wisdom here?}

P7 10 The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can show the king's matter: therefore there is no king, lord, nor ruler, that asked such things at any magician, or astrologer, or Chaldean. ^{Nobody can do what you ask and no king would ask such a thing!}

P8 11 And it is a rare thing that the king requireth, and there is none other that can show it before the king, except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh. ^{Only God can read our minds boys and girls. Even evil men like these guys know that. So watch what you are thinking!!}

P9 12 For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the wise men of Babylon.

P10 13 And the decree went forth that the wise men should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain. Daniel and his friends were not called to give the meaning of the dream but they were counted among the wise. Nebby has decided to kill all the wise men. Not a good idea his wisdom has left.

P11 14 Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise men of Babylon:

P12 15 He answered and said to Arioch the king's captain, Why is the decree so hasty in a hurry or rushing from the king? Then Arioch made the thing known to Daniel.

P13 16 Then Daniel went in, and desired of the king that he would give him time, and that he would show the king the interpretation.

P14 Daniel and his friends are to be killed because the King thinks no one can tell his dream and what it means. What will Daniel do? What will his friends do?
