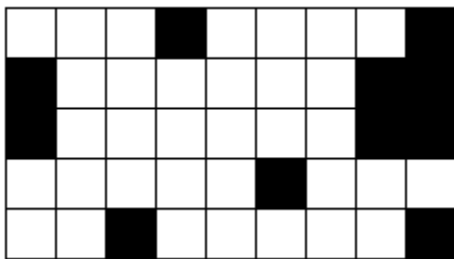

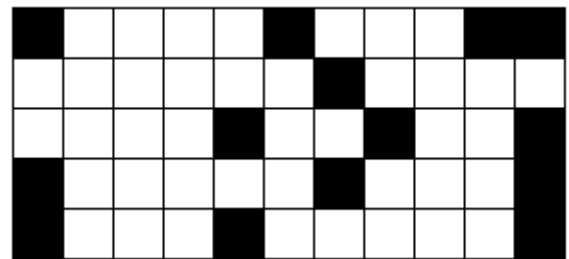

## Doing Right Will Cost You Something!

Last Time.... Dan 3:13 Then Nebuchadnezzar in his rage and fury commanded to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Then they brought these men before the king. 14 Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, Is it true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor worship the golden image which I have set up? **A SECOND CHANCE TO DO WRONG!** — 15 Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the image which I have made; well: but if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and **who is that God** that shall deliver you out of my hands?

P1 16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, **we** are not **careful** <sup>scared or worried</sup> to answer thee in this matter.

All for one and one for all! These guys stick together! It is sometimes easier to do right if you see others doing right too! This is a real good reason for us to do right. (discuss) Notice too that they are NOT afraid of what Nebby can do to them!

P2 Dan 3:17 If it be so, our **God** whom we serve **is able** to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 **But if not**, be it known unto thee, O king, **that we will not serve thy gods**, nor **worship** the golden image which thou hast set up.

Here we see the character of the 3 boys. They KNOW that GOD IS ABLE to stop Nebby but they ALSO KNOW that He may not. Just because God does not stop something from happening to us it DOES NOT mean he has left us. Remember God knows the ending before it happens and He always has a plan. We need to learn, as Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego did, to trust God no matter what. These 3 boys choose to die rather than to do wrong because they KNOW the Lord! They KNOW He will take care of them now or later.

P3 Dan 3:19 Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, <sup>gave into his emotions, stopped thinking</sup> and the form of his visage <sup>how he looked</sup> was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: therefore he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was **wont** <sup>dreamed (discuss)</sup> to be heated.

Nebby gets mad! You have seen people do this, maybe you have done this. When a person does not get their way and stops thinking they give into their emotions. Even the way they look changes and then they make bad decisions! (discuss in class) The Word "wont" actually means dreamed. Nebby was so mad, so given to his emotions, that he was dreaming that the furnace could be heated that hot. It was dangerous to heat it that hot... people could die!

P4 Dan 3:20 And he commanded **the most mighty men** that were in his army to bind <sup>tie up</sup> Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and to cast <sup>throw</sup> them into the burning fiery furnace.

Based on what we have discussed in P3 Why, do you THINK, Nebby command "the most mighty men" to bind and cast the boys into the fire?

P5 Dan 3:21 Then these men were bound in their coats, their hosen, and their hats, and their other garments, and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

P6 Dan 3:22 Therefore because the king's commandment was **urgent**, <sup>hasty, not thinking</sup> and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew <sup>killed</sup> those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.



Nebby calls his bravest men to throw the boys into the fire because the fire is so hot. These brave men are killed by the fire because it is so hot. They must have caught on fire while they were still carrying these guys to the mouth of the furnace! Before they are killed by the heat they manage to throw Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego into the furnace.

P7 Dan 3:23 And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

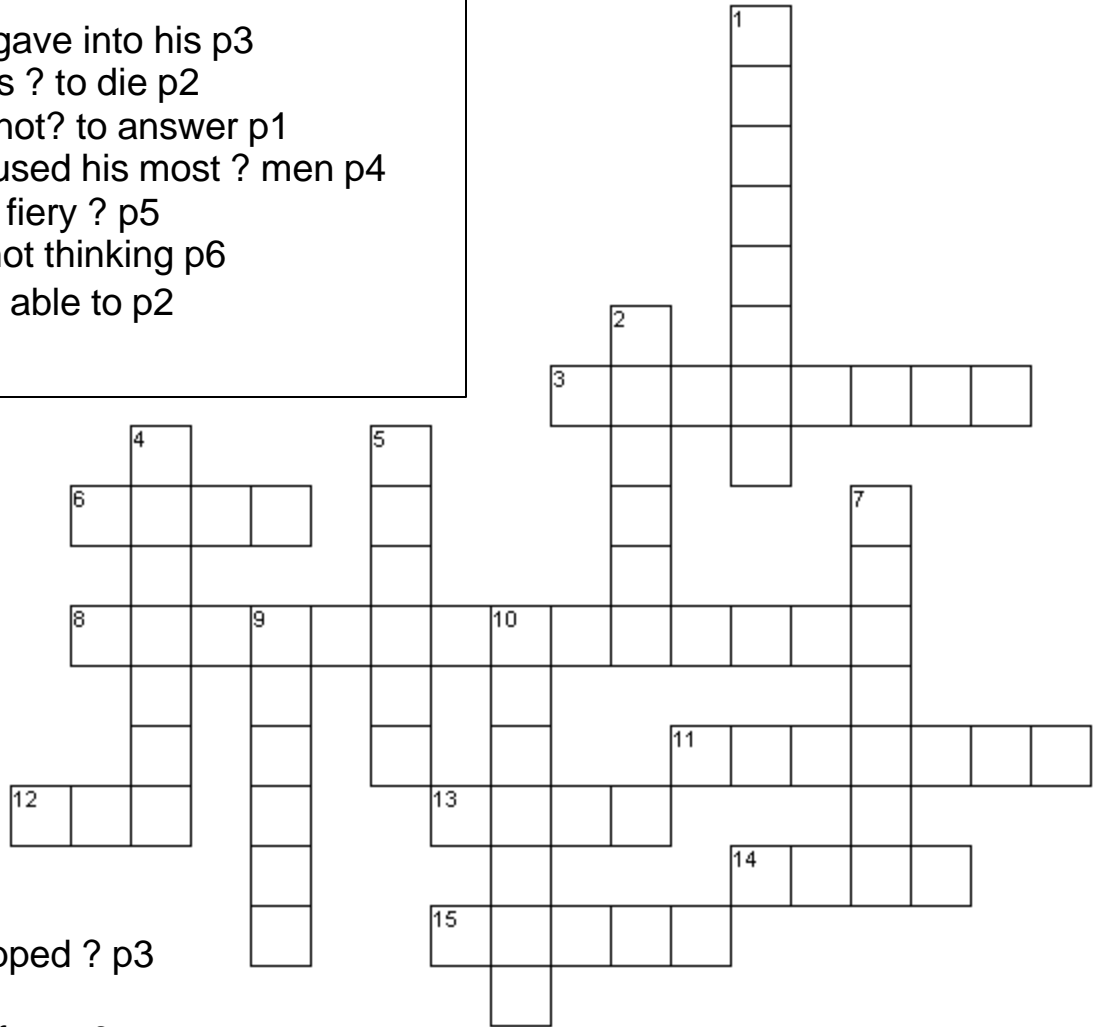
